Notes

- 1) Different collection periods, methodologies and under-reporting from a small percentage of schools may result in differences between the records of your province/territory and the national student and faculty data. Please consult the "Survey Methodology" document.
- 2) The 2003-2004 survey was sent to 134 schools offering nursing programs; 116 schools completed the survey; 15 CEGEPs, 1 B.C. college, 1 Ont. college and 1 Que. university did not complete the survey.
- 3) Nurse practitioner programs may be offered as part of baccalaureate, post RN or master's degree programs, and schools may report separate program data for these "integrated" programs. In these instances, data are recorded under the nurse practitioner program and the corresponding degree program.
- 4) Data include diploma, diploma exit option, bridge to RN and DEC programs. Bridge to RN programs vary between 2 and 2.5 years' duration.
- 5) Data include diploma programs where schools are no longer accepting new entrants, but continue to educate those students already enrolled.
