Board of Directors

2014 Elections: 1 President-Elect position and one Treasurer position is available. 2 Director positions are available in the Quebec Region, 2 Director positions are available in the Ontario Region, and 1 Director position is available in the Western/Northwestern Region.

Meeting requirements/Commitments: Spring: two-day, in-person meeting (May); Fall: two-day, in-person meeting (November), three or four teleconferences a year, weekly correspondence, and Board members act as a liaison to one of the CASN Committees (five or six teleconferences a year).

Responsibilities of the <u>President-Elect</u> (from CASN Bylaws)

- In the absence or disability of the President, the President-Elect shall perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President:
 - Preside at all meetings of the Council and of the Board of Directors, see that all
 orders and resolutions of the Board are carried into effect, advocate on behalf of the
 Association, and serve as spokesperson for the Association. The President shall give
 or cause to be given notice of all meetings of the Council and of the Board of
 Directors.
- Term of office 2 year term, followed by the position of President 2 year term, subsequently followed by the position of Past-President – 1 year term (5 year total commitment).

Responsibilities of the <u>Treasurer</u> (from CASN Bylaws)

- On behalf of the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall oversee the financial stewardship of the Association and shall have custody of the funds and securities of the Association.
- Term of office 3 years.

Responsibilities of the <u>Directors</u> (from CASN Bylaws)

- Govern the affairs of the Association and are responsible for the policy of the Association.
- Set the annual budget and make expenditures to conduct the business of the Association.
- Delegate and designate by resolution the right to employ and pay salaries to employees.
- Vote as a Board on matters to determine best course of action for issues with respect to policy and governance.
- Term of Office 2 years.
