Barbara MacKinnon is the Director of Environmental Research at the New Brunswick Lung Association and is the coordinator of the Canadian Network for Human Health and the Environment.

She was a member of two research teams spearheaded by the New Brunswick Lung Association to conduct the first-even study of indoor air quality in First Nations housing, and the first Canadian study of the exposure of children to diesel exhaust from school buses.

Projects that she is currently working on with the Lung Association include children's environmental health, Radon in homes, the new Air Quality Health Index, energy efficient municipalities and wood smoke.
