Mission

GANES provides the informed international voice on the contribution of professional nursing education and scholarship to improving global health and health care.

Focus

GANES constitutes the only international body providing strategic-level expertise in the education and professional development of nurses worldwide. Its membership comprises national associations of Nursing Deans and Schools of Nursing and is able to offer information, support and advice to healthcare policy makers and nurse educators across the world.

Mandate

GANES's mandate is to work in partnership with global and national organizations to raise awareness of the key role of nurse education in the improvement of global health and quality of care. To conduct the business of the GANES, an Executive Committee consisting of at least six representatives from member organizations will be selected to serve four-year terms on this leadership body.

GANES Activities

- Brings leaders in nursing education from around the globe together to share insights and ideas on issues of shared concern (the global migration of nurses, sustaining the nursing workforce globally, etc.) and provide information and advice on education processes and standards for nursing role development worldwide.
- Provide accurate and contemporary data and advice to global policy organizations, governments, and NGOs on issues related to the education and professional development of nurses.
- Provide the infrastructure for a new international network of nurse education leaders.
- Provide collegial support, advice and mentorship to those responsible for developing nurse education worldwide.
- Promote the development of a robust evidence base for nursing practice and nursing education through rigorous research.

Meetings

GANES hosts international conferences in different countries every other year. The Executive Committee meets more regularly to conduct the business of the alliance.

Membership

Regular Membership

Only national organizations (i.e. Councils of Deans of Nursing or Associations of Schools of Nursing) are eligible for regular membership. One national organization shall represent each country. Member organizations shall have three nominated representatives. Each regular member (i.e. each country) shall have one vote.

Associate Membership

In special instances where a nation does not have a Council of Deans or an Association of Schools of Nursing, an individual from that nation may join as an associate member for a prescribed period of time. GANES will work with associate members to assist them in forming an organization that will represent their nation. Associate members will not vote.
