Biography Judith A. Ritchie, N., PhD

For nearly a quarter of a century, Judith Ritchie has been seeking ways to link nursing practice and nursing research. Since her appointment in 2000 as Associate Director for Nursing Research at the McGill University Health Centre, her research has focused on



knowledge translation and nursing services administration and she collaborates with her leadership colleagues in practice, administration and the university to foster those linkages. Her currently funded research projects are mainly related to implementation of practice guidelines and the contextual variables influencing successful implementation of evidence-based practice and decision-making.
