
 professionally oriented 'service' - using knowledge for the purpose of testing its practicality and utility

•End result is often more substance for the scholarship of discovery - there is intimate interaction between theory and practice such that one renews and informs the other


•May come out of the experience with questions or issues that require further exploration or revisiting of what is known – <u>praxis</u>






 Some nursing authors claimed that the concept of service as a component of nursing scholarship is under-explored and poorly understood
