2015 Request for Applications: Canadian Consortium for Neurodegeneration in Aging (CCNA) Training Award for Nursing Students

1. Program Objective

This program is designed to support a nursing trainee enrolled in a Masters or PhD program in Nursing, working on a project that is a component of a [Canadian Consortium for Neurodegeneration in Aging](#) (CCNA) associated team research plan.

2. Mechanisms of Support

The funding partners, [Canadian Nurses Foundation](#) (CNF) and the [Alzheimer Society Research Program](#) (ASRP), will co-fund:

Type	Duration	Amount	Eligibility
Masters Award	1 or 2 years	\$20,000/yr	Enrolled in a Thesis-based Masters program in Nursing at a Canadian University at the time of and for the duration of funding.
Doctoral Award	1, 2 or 3 years	\$25,000/yr	Must be within the first 18 months of a PhD program in Nursing within a Canadian University

***The candidate's supervisor must be working within a CCNA associated team, platform, or cross-cutting program and their project must align with the research plan of the CCNA.**

3. Applications

Applications to the program must be submitted by November 28th, 2015 to ASC, using the online portal: www.asc.reviewroom.com. Applicants to this program will automatically be considered for a Doctoral Award in ASRP's concurrent competition.
