First as a faculty member in the collaborative partnership with the University of Alberta (1998-2008), then as the BScN Steering Committee (2007-2015), and currently within the Department of Nursing Science and Faculty of Nursing. In these roles I have contributed to ensure decisions and policies were grounded in BEST practice (not limited to: clinical practice guidelines for students, missed academic experiences, student conduct, gift giving and receiving).
