## TEACHING TERM APPOINTMENTS (36-Month Teaching Term Appointments - 3 positions)

Memorial University is the largest university in Atlantic Canada. As the province's only university, Memorial plays an integral role in the education and cultural life of Newfoundland and Labrador. Offering diverse undergraduate and graduate programs to almost 18,000 students, Memorial provides a distinctive and stimulating environment for learning in St. John's, a safe and friendly city with great historic charm, a vibrant cultural life, and easy access to a wide range of outdoor activities.

The Faculty of Nursing is located on the university campus and offers programs leading to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (four-year and accelerated options), a Master of Science in Nursing (MScN), practicum and nurse practitioner options, a Post Master's Nurse Practitioner (NP) Graduate Diploma, and a PhD in Nursing.

The Faculty of Nursing has three 36-month teaching term appointments for applicants who must be licensed as Nurse Practitioners with the College of Registered Nurses of Newfoundland and Labrador (CRNNL) and available to teach in the MScN Practicum and NP options as well as in the BScN (Collaborative) Program. A 36-month teaching term appointment requires teaching in the classroom, laboratory as well as in clinical settings. The successful candidate must provide a criminal record screening, vulnerable sector check, and an up-to-date immunization record.

The minimum qualifications for a teaching term appointment are a Master of Nursing Degree (NP stream/option) or a Post Master's Nurse Practitioner Graduate Diploma. In addition, three to five years of NP clinical experience is a requirement for teaching in the Nurse Practitioner program.

A complete application is comprised of the following: (a) a letter of introduction outlining relevant clinical and teaching experience; (b) evidence of effective teaching; (c) your curriculum vitae; and (d) the names and contact information of three references.
