## **About the Program**

Since 2006, the Regional Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing (RDPN) program has been the only psychiatric nursing program offered province-wide in B.C. through a hybrid, blended delivery format. This 8-semester, 147-credit program engages students in synchronous and asynchronous learning via online theory courses, in-person lab simulations at one of our five regional lab spaces, and clinical practice experiences that expose students to a variety of health statuses across the lifespan and varying complexities. The RDPN program facilitates simulation lab courses across five regional lab sites in B.C.: Surrey, Duncan, Kamloops, Kelowna, and Prince George.

We are seeking a talented nursing or psychiatric nursing professional with simulation expertise to oversee the effective and efficient operation of Stenberg College Simulation Labs for the RDPN Program, collaborating with program leadership, supporting coordinators and assistants, and lab faculty to ensure the successful delivery of lab courses.

The Lab Simulation Manager supports the RDPN Program Director/Program Dean in ensuring the effective operation of lab simulation education delivery while overseeing curriculum quality, faculty engagement, and student success. This position is responsible for ensuring quality assurance within the curriculum development process of simulation lab content under the supervision of the Program Director, managing lab resources, and maintaining all regional lab facilities, equipment, and supplies. Additionally, the Lab Simulation Manager collaborates with faculty and staff to enhance educational outcomes through effective lab education delivery, focusing on developing faculty's simulation skills to improve instructional practices. Furthermore, the manager ensures faculty and student engagement and success through audits, evaluations, research, and consultation.

## **Successful Applicants Will:**

 Be a Registered Psychiatric Nurse (RPN, preferred) or Registered Nurse (RN) with active, in-good-standing licensure with BCCNM.

- Have a minimum of 5-7 years of nursing experience; 10 years preferred.
- Hold a Master's Degree in Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, Adult Education, Curriculum Design, or Leadership (candidates with a Master's degree in progress will also be considered).
- Have experience teaching nursing students in either an academic or clinical capacity.
- Have experience in high, medium, and low-fidelity simulations (CASN or other certification in simulation education preferred).
- Demonstrate leadership skills and have experience leading and mentoring teams.
- Be familiar with the Microsoft Office Suite of products.
- Receive additional consideration if they have experience with Moodle and other online learning management systems and technologies.
- Be committed to understanding the needs of a diverse population of faculty, staff, and students, and be able to work effectively with individuals from various backgrounds.
